## **PROGRAMS**



## **NEWSLETTER**

By then my lab tests were out of date and I had to get cleared (AGAIN!) by my primary care doctor. Fortunately, he was very kind and scheduled an emergency appointment, so all systems are go, and I am now scheduled for Friday the 13<sup>th</sup>! Go figure.....

In the meantime, I am enjoying stitching on Winter Scenery and a Margaret Bendig piece, Tequila Sunrise, which is the on-going project for our sister chapter, Road Runner Needlers. Tequila Sunrise is from Needlepointers Jul/Aug/Sept 2019 and lends itself to personal choices in colorways. I plan to rename mine as Tequila Sunrise will no longer be appropriate. Margaret has charted some beautiful stitches. Her designs are always a further opportunity to learn.

For the last couple of months, I have been helping a friend who was a great stitcher but after surgery, is now struggling to remember how to translate a chart to canvas. At first it was stitch by stitch but now she is making real progress. It's been a great adventure. We are both working on Contemporary Bargello from a long-ago issue of Needlepoint Now. One interesting note: She chose to use 18/inch canvas but the pattern and most stitchers use the recommended 24/inch congress cloth. It doesn't sound like much but it's a full one third larger. Another difference is the working method. My friend started at the bottom and is working her way up. I started at the bottom and then shifted to top down; I can't remember why. Both methods are working fine as bargello is easy to compensate stitches where necessary.

Are you having adventures? Share them with me, I would love to include them in the newsletter. Stay well, wash your hands, and be happy while stitching, or reading, or binge-watching your favorite shows. Don't forget, supporting the Girl Scouts is a wonderful thing but has a down-side.
