Our Fall project will be a foldable ort box. You will need interlock 18ct canvas - 12x16". If you have any of this canvas in your stash, earmark it for this project. I will have a supply of white canvas for anyone who sends me a reply to the email I sent out on March 23rd. You can also use 18 count mono canvas, but the box will not fold as easily as using interlock. Just be aware that the white canvas will show through parts of your stitching. More details to come.
