<u>September - January Program – Ort</u> *Box with a Twist*

Our Fall Project continues this month.

What to bring:

Your printed stitch guide. This has been sent to each of you (it does require color printing) please print and bring with



you. If you need a printed copy, there is a charge of \$5. Please let Kate know – AHEAD of time – if you need a printed copy and it will be ready for you at the meeting. We <u>are not</u> making additional copies "just in case."

Normal stitching tools Frame stand if you desire.

Lighting if you need it – it must be battery operated.

Project timeline:

December: the bottom square is the remaining square we will work on. It is important that we have all the squares complete so that we can move on to the construction of the box and then the lining at our January meeting.

January: after surviving the holidays and stitching all the squares we will work on the box assembly and review the lining instructions.

A word of caution when stitching – it is vital that your counting is "spot on," if it is not, the borders and finishing will not work.

- * As always, please read all instructions before starting.
- ** Also send me a text or email if you are not at a meeting to sign up for a particular project you would like to do.
