The budget is a work in progress at this point. We will be having a stash sale in the Spring. Our guild has had two large stash donations in 2023.

Jan Prestin won the 50/50 Raffle; the amount was \$39.00. Congratulations Jan and thank you to Nancy Russell for organizing and selling tickets for this event.

Installation of Officers will be at the January 18 th meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:50 followed by our amazing Holiday Party and gift exchange.
