Programs

<u>September - January Program - Ort Box with a Twist</u>

Our Fall Project continues this month. We will work on the side squares (note that they will be the folded squares) and have them complete by the November meeting.

What to bring:

Your printed stitch guide. This
has been sent to each of you (it
does require color printing)
please print and bring with you.



If you need a printed copy, there is a charge of \$5. Please let Kate know – AHEAD of time – if you need a printed copy and it will be ready for you at the meeting. We <u>are not</u> making additional copies "just in case."

- \$10 for the canvas (if you write a check make it out to Saguaro Stitchers).
- This project does require a frame the canvas is 12"x16" so plan accordingly and have the frame assembled and ready to mount the canvas. You need to bring tacks or staple gun.
- Your threads of choice (which are listed on the 1st page of the stitch guide).
- Normal stitching tools
- Frame stand if you desire.
- Lighting if you need it it must be battery operated.

Project timeline:

- **November:** we will continue working on the squares.
- **December:** the bottom square is the remaining square we will work on. It is important that we have all the squares complete so that we can move on to the construction of the box and then the lining at our January meeting.
- **January:** after surviving the holidays and stitching all the squares we will work on the box assembly and review the lining instructions.
- A word of caution when stitching it is vital that your counting is "spot on," if it is not, the borders and finishing will not work.
- * As always, please read all instructions before starting.
- ** Also send me a text or email if you are not at a meeting to sign up for a particular project you would like to do.
