# **Programs**

#### September - Ort Box with a Twist

We will begin our Fall project at our September meeting. If you signed up for this project, please review the information below. If you were unsure if you wanted to do this project but have decided you want to participate, please contact Kate via email or text immediately as canvas may not be available.



#### What to bring:

Your printed stitch guide. This has been sent to each of you (it does require color printing) please print and bring with you. If you need a printed copy, there is a charge of \$5. Please let Kate know – AHEAD of time – if you need a printed copy and it will be ready for you at the meeting. We <u>are not making additional copies</u> "just in case." (408) 828-2942 this is a California area code and is correct

- \$10 for the canvas (if you write a check make it out to Saguaro Stitchers).
- This project does require a frame the canvas is 12"x16" so plan accordingly and have the frame assembled and ready to mount the canvas. You need to bring tacks or staple gun.
- Your threads of choice (which are listed on the 1<sup>st</sup> page of the stitch guide).
- Normal stitching supplies
- Frame stand if you desire.
- Lighting if you need it it must be battery operated.

### **Project timeline:**

- **September:** baste the canvas per the instructions and start with the pocket squares as directed. You need to have the pocket squares complete by the October meeting.
- **October:** we will work on the side squares (note that they will be the folded squares) and have them complete by the November meeting.
- **December:** the bottom square is the remaining square we will work on. It is important that we have all the squares complete so that we can move on to the construction of the box and then the lining at our January meeting.
- **January:** after surviving the holidays and stitching all the squares we will work on the box assembly and review the lining instructions.
- A word of caution when stitching it is vital that your counting is "spot on," if it is not, the borders and finishing will not work.

- Exhibitors must belong to an Arizona chapter of the Embroiderers' Guild of America, the American Needlepoint Guild, the Smocking Arts Guild of America, or the International Organization of Lace.
- Entry forms will be available both online and downloadable by January 15, 2026.
- Entry fees: \$7.00 for the 1<sup>st</sup> item and \$5.00 for each additional item. There is no limit to the number of entries per stitcher. If you volunteer as a docent for the show (3 contiguous hours), your first exhibit item is free (a \$7.00 value).
