Class topics will include a discussion of how the colorways were chosen, Watercolour manipulation, stitch selection, and a little color theory.

The threads in the photographs of the alternate colorways are shown in the order they will be used, starting in the center - only small amounts of the first four threads are used. The colorway is named for the Watercolour used for the stars and is the 6th thread (the very middle).
